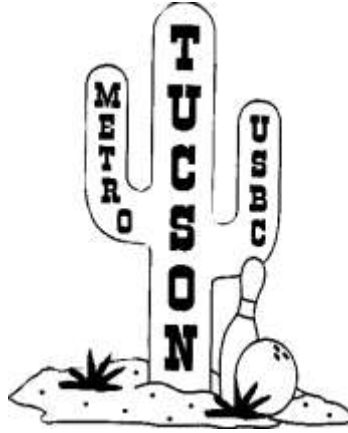

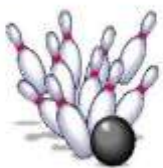

Notes to Team Captains:

- A) Some scheduled squads may be cancelled due to lack of participation. Team captains will be notified if cancellations take place.

- B) No guarantee will be given for any Team or Doubles/Singles entry in any squad. The earlier you mail your entry form in, the better chances your entry has for bowling in your first choice squad selection.

- C) Early Bird ONLY means your TEAM entry will be placed into a drawing for refund of your team Entry Fee. It should not be taken as a preference for squad selection.

**Tucson Metro USBC
Annual Women's Tournament Rules**

1. **All entrants** must be members of Arizona State USBC and Tucson Metro USBC. The Tournament will consist of a **four-woman team event**, a doubles event, a singles event and an All Events.
2. **Multiple participation** will be allowed in the Team Event only. Members will be allowed to enter the Team Event twice. A minimum of two players on the team must be changed to qualify as a second entry.
3. **A member** entering doubles must also enter the singles event.
4. **Scheduling** Entries will be scheduled in the order they are received and according to request where possible. Each event will be bowled on a pair of lanes. D/S will criss-cross pairs.
5. **Handicap** will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
6. **Averages** Qualifying averages, in order of acceptability shall be:
 - A. 2010-11 season highest USBC book average of 21 games. USBC Rule 319a-2. does not apply.
 - B. Highest average of 21 games or more in the same league as of 12/22/11 (specify league)
 - C. Highest 2011 summer average of 21 games or more in the same league (specify league/Verification Required)
 - D. Highest average of 12 games or more in the same league by tournament start date. (Verification Required)
 - E. Bowlers using a book average from another association must submit written verification with entry.
 - F. Bowlers who have none of the above will be assigned an average of 220.
 - G. Bowlers must use the same hand to deliver the ball in tournament competition as she used to establish her entering average. Non-compliance will result in disqualification and forfeit of entry fee. USBC Rule 328 shall also apply and the bowler's average will be rerated to 220 if no average has been established with the opposite hand.
 - H. USBC Rule 319a-3 will apply.
7. **All Events** All events fee is optional. The All Events score is the total of the bowler's actual scores including handicap using the team score where she paid her All Events fee plus her doubles and singles scores. All Events score will be based on the highest score bowled. Paid All Events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces the original entrant in all three events. A bowler who is not bowling in all three events may pay the all events fee and be placed on a substitute list. This fee is non-refundable.
8. **Awards**
 - A. Cash awards will be paid in a 1 in 5 ratio in each event by division. Scores used to determine standings will be the total of actual score bowled plus handicap. Ties for cash prizes will be combined and divided evenly between the tied entrants. Ties for last place will be paid in full.
 - B. A suitable award will be selected and awarded based on Actual Scores for champions in each division for Team, Doubles, Singles, All Events, High Series and High Game. Only bowlers who have paid the All Events fee prior to December 14, 2011, will be eligible for All Events prize money. In the event of a tie the money is split. Trophies will be awarded for All Events Scratch division winners. See Rule 306d. In the event of a tie for trophies, duplicates will be presented. If a team has a sponsor, a Sponsor's trophy will be presented. Champions will take their place in the cash award list based on their actual score plus handicap by division.
 - C. USBC emblems will be awarded to the Champions in both scratch and handicapped divisions, in each event.
 - D. All prize money collected in an event will be returned to the participants in that event.
 - E. All tournament prize checks will be mailed to the team captains no earlier than 5 days after the tournament ends and no later than 30 days after the tournament ends.
9. **Registration** All entrants will register one-half (1/2) hour prior to team event, one-half (1/2) hour prior to D/S. Certification card must be presented. Team captains should have entire team present before registration.
10. **Substitute and Late Bowlers** Substitutes should be reported at least one (1) hour prior to the time scheduled to bowl. Any bowler arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame being bowled by her team. Entries accepting a last minute substitute must retain the substitute for all three (3) games of that event. If an entrant is late for the doubles event, the entrant present shall bowl her singles event first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is finished and a substitute cannot be found, the entrant present shall bowl her games in the doubles event in order to qualify for All Events.
11. **Fees** Amounts are listed on the tournament entry. **NO ENTRY MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED AFTER BEING PROCESSED.**
12. **Physically impaired** Physically impaired bowlers will be welcome to enter all events of the tournament.
13. **Refreshments** No beverages or food will be allowed in the bowling settee area. **ONLY** securely covered drinks will be allowed on the counter directly behind the settee area. All other food and drinks must be on the tables behind the bowling area. This applies to scorers, guests and bowlers. No one other than bowlers, scorers and tournament officials will be allowed in the bowling area.
14. **Tournament games** cannot be re-bowled except as authorized by the tournament manager when scores are irretrievably lost in the scoring process.
15. Tournament Manager will be paid \$1.00 per bowler, per event, excluding all events.
16. **Rules** Any protest or appeal for any reason must be filed within 48 hours after the team or single bowler bowls the games in which gave rise to the protest or appeal. The protest or appeal must be in writing and the grounds for the protest or appeal briefly stated. USBC Rule 329 will apply. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament manager within 24 hours. Tucson Metro USBC Board of Directors reserves the right to change the name of any team considered to be derogatory to the sport of bowling. Rules not covered above will be resolved by the Tucson Metro USBC Board of Directors. USBC Rule 319c, d & e do not apply.
